California	California has not adopted the model act but my understanding is part of the model act was based on California law. See California Corporations Code 1505.
Colorado	Colorado has adopted parts of the Model Registered Agent Act, for example, service of process through mailing effective July 1, 2004. Last year SB12-123 was passed to include the Commercial registered agent section but included the effective date to be 90 days after the secretary of state has certified to the reviser of statutes that the necessary computer system changes are in place. We anticipate making these computer changes sometime in the next three years.

District of Columbia	In the District of Columbia we have adopted Business Organizations Code of 2010. As a part of that overhaul we have adopted all the latest uniform laws in the country including Model Registered Agent Act.
