<b>Oregon</b>	We produce the new notaries list weekly at \$50 per week. A tab-delimited file of all active notaries (not the complete database) is also available for \$50.
<b>Pennsylvania</b>	Pennsylvania charges \$50 for a CD of active Notaries Public (that's about 80,000 names and business address contact information).

<b>Texas</b>	In Texas customers who want updates for weekly or monthly commission data may subscribe. The fee is \$230 month.
