<b>Pennsylvania</b>	<p>Pennsylvania has always issued subsistence certificates (versus good standings), but here is our relatively new statute saying that:</p> <p>15 Pa.C.S.A. § 145 § 145. Subsistence certificate</p> <p>(a) General rule.--On request of a person, the department shall issue:                      (1) a subsistence certificate for a domestic filing entity or domestic limited liability partnership; or                      (2) a certificate of registration for a registered foreign association.                      (b) Contents of certificate.--A certificate under subsection (a) must state:                      (1) the name of the domestic filing entity or domestic limited liability partnership or the name under which the registered foreign association is registered in this Commonwealth;                      (2) in the case of a domestic filing entity or domestic limited liability partnership, that the entity is currently subsisting on the records of the department; and                      (3) in the case of a registered foreign association, that it is registered to do business in this Commonwealth.                      (c) Effect of certificate.--Subject to any qualification stated in the certificate, a certificate issued by the department under subsection (a) may be relied on as conclusive evidence of the facts stated in the certificate.                      2014, Oct. 22, P.L. 2640, No. 172, § 5, effective July 1, 2015.</p>
