Jurisdiction	Question(s)
	<p>In Iowa, we're required to send biennial report delinquent notices (paper) in June; and dissolutions (paper) in August to the registered agent. Throughout the rest of the year, we send biennial report reminder notices via email [as a courtesy]... also to the registered agent.</p> <p>We do not have a good means to collect the registered agent email addresses (we ask for the agent email address at the time a biennial report is filed, but we often get the filer's email address instead).</p> <p>Questions for your jurisdiction:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How do you collect the registered agent email address? 2. How do you keep the agent email address updated? 3. Which email addresses do you use for filing reminders? The filer (remitter) email address? Agent email? Can anyone sign up for notices?

Corporations Canada	<p>At Corporations Canada we don't especially collect the registered agent email address, we generally collect the filer's email address. We don't update the email address, the client must subscribe to reminder notices and is then able to update by connecting their account. Furthermore, anyone can sign up to receive reminder notices.</p>

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District of Columbia	<p>In DC we require the email address as a part of the listing of commercial agent (basically to formally become the agent).</p> <p>We send notices to all commercial agents twice a year for report reminders as well as notices before revocations.</p> <p>Agents also get emails from our system anytime someone picks them as the agent or changes from them as the agent so agents get a variety of emails from us.</p> <p>We also store user account emails and emails for noncommercial agent that we collect as a part of biennial report. We have not used those emails for notices but planning to do that soon.</p> <p>We will also have email subscription for anyone to subscribe for alerts for any given company.</p>

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Louisiana	<p>Louisiana does the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.) We collect the agent's email address when the filer submits an online original or subsequent filing. We send an email to the agent asking that they accept the appointment. 2.) We do not keep the agent email address updated. It is only updated if the customer changes the agent. 3.) We use the email address of the account holder. When filing in Louisiana the customer must create and verify an account through www.geauxBIZ.com. It is up to the user to update their email address. We do offer electronic notification and anyone can sign up to receive on any business. Again it would be up to the customer to update this email address if need be.

Minnesota	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How do you collect the registered agent email address? We do not collect registered agent email address. 2. How do you keep the agent email address updated? N/A 3. Which email addresses do you use for filing reminders? The filer (remitter) email address? Agent email? Can anyone sign up for notices? Email notifications will be sent to the Official Email Address on record. If the amendment or renewal changes the official email address on record, then the email notification will be sent to both the previous and current email address. If no changes are made to the official email address, then the notification will just be sent to the current email address on record (if any).

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<p>North Carolina</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How do you collect the registered agent email address? <p>We don't sent out emails correspondence or notices to every registered agent. We keep some (about 50) registered agent email addresses for those with a high number of customers, i.e., CT Corporation Systems; CSC etc. Our IT Dept. gives us the email addresses. Other smaller registered agents we seek out their email address on a website or on the annual report form.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. How do you keep the agent email address updated? <p>Through constant emailing. Any errors are removed from the address listing for the RA on our system. If it is a large provider, we search out a new email address.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Which email addresses do you use for filing reminders? The filer (remitter) email address? Agent email? Can anyone sign up for notices? <p>We only manually email the registered agent the reminders. By statute we are required to go through the registered agent for notices or demands on the company. If the company has signed up for enotification when a notice is filed, the company will get an e-mail at that time.</p> <p>We do have a no cost e-notification subscription service where anyone can sign up for notifications. They have a choice whether they only want notified when a status may or is changing or get notification on every filing.</p>
