

**Kimberley Perondi** was appointed Deputy Secretary for Commercial Recordings by the Nevada Secretary of State in September 2016. Ms. Perondi is responsible for overseeing the Division that processes and maintains the organizational and amendatory documents of more than 375,000 business entities on file with the Secretary of State's office. She also oversees the filing and processing of trademarks, trade names, service marks, and rights of publicity, Uniform Commercial Code financing statements, changes, lien searches, federal tax liens and utility filings. Ms. Perondi assists the Secretary of State in developing, reviewing and presenting legislation pertaining to the Commercial Recordings Division, working with legislators, the Business Law Section of the State Bar Association and the Nevada Registered Agent Association. Ms. Perondi also serves as Chair of the State Records Committee.

Ms. Perondi's public service career began in 1993 with the Nevada Department of Taxation. In 1997 she joined the Department of Administration and served in various roles, including Assistant Chief Procurement Officer for the Purchasing Division, where she managed large-dollar contracting activities and provided instruction on statewide procurement practices.

As former CFO of her family's property management corporation, as well as having owned her own business, Ms. Perondi brings a balanced perspective to her position of the needs of business owners and government.
