Reasons for the Article 9 Amendments

- IACA Requested Changes of the Permanent Editorial Board in December 2007.
- Non-Uniform Amendments:
 - Texas
 - Nebraska
 - Tennessee

Where are the Article 9 Amendments Now?

- Presented to the ALI on May 17, 2010.
- New Draft released on May 13, 2010.
 - Changes from Style Committee.
 - Final due to ULC on June 1, 2010.
- Expected Implementation: July 2013.

Transition Rules

- PART 8, TRANSITION PROVISIONS FOR 2010 AMENDMENTS
- 9-801. EFFECTIVE DATE. This [Act] takes effect on July 1, 2013.
